Adoption of Agenda

Moved by Bruski, seconded by Chalupniczak to adopt the agenda as presented. Motion carried unanimously.

New Business:

Purchase of a Tractor

Moved by Chalupniczak, seconded by Nowak to purchase a used 22 HP 1998 John Deere Lawn Tractor with a 2-stage snowblower, lawn sweeper and all attachments with a price range between \$5800.00 to \$6300.00. Motion carried unanimously.

Village Resident's Grass Cutting

Moved by Bruski, seconded by Chalupniczak, to mow the village resident's grass on Third Street one time, and send them the bill for the service. If the bill is not paid, follow through with the ordinance rules and place it on the resident's tax bill for collection. Motion carried unanimously.

New Sidewalks

Since the village has an approved permit to put in new sidewalks from the Posen School driveway north to Oak Street, the contractor will be contacted to begin the process.

Moved by Ataman, seconded by Chalupniczak that there being no further business to come before the Council, the President adjourned the meeting at 7:00 p.m. Motion carried unanimously.
